

## Information on Final Exam

- When** The final exam is in the regular classroom, Center 109, on Monday December 5, 11:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Please arrive a few minutes early to ensure the exam starts on time and that you get the full time allotted to it.
- Topics on test** The exam is comprehensive and will cover the material of homework assignments 1–8.
- Study your lecture notes, the homework problems, and the relevant parts of the book. For additional practice problems, do problems similar to the assigned ones.
- Supplies** Please bring your student ID card, pencils, erasers, a calculator, and a “cheat sheet” (described below). We’ll supply a test book, so you don’t need a blue book or scantron.
- No other resources are permitted. No books. If you bring your cell phone, pager, or other electronic device, be sure that it is disabled and stashed away.**
- “Cheat Sheet”** You may bring one **double sided** sheet of notes,  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 11''$ . It must be written by hand by you in pen or pencil; it may not be produced by any other means (computer, photocopying, purchasing pre-made reference cards, etc.).
