Final Exam Announcement**

- Time and place** The final exam will be in the regular classroom (WLH 2113) on Monday March 16, 3–6 p.m.
- Material** The final is comprehensive. It covers the whole quarter.  
Study your lecture notes, class slides and handouts, the homework problems, and the parts of the book we covered. For additional practice problems, do problems similar to the assigned ones.  
If you want to use your homework 9 for studying for the exam, please photocopy it before you turn it in. Your previous homeworks can be picked up from Chris.
- Supplies** Please bring your student ID card, pencils, erasers, “cheat sheet” (described below), and a calculator.  
We’ll supply a test book, so you don’t need a blue book or scantron.  
If your calculator does hypothesis testing, you may not use the hypothesis testing features for the test; you will have to show the steps involved in hypothesis testing, but may use your calculator for the arithmetic part of it.  
**No other resources are permitted. If you bring your cell phone, pager, or other electronic device, be sure that it is disabled and stashed away.**
- “Cheat Sheet”** You may bring one **double-sided** sheet of notes,  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 11''$ . It must be written by hand by you in pen or pencil; it may not be produced by any other means (computer, photocopying, purchasing pre-made reference cards, etc.).  
You do not need to copy data from the statistical tables from the appendix in the textbook (Tables A.1, A.2, A.3); similar tables will be provided to you.
