

Gradescope Regrade Request Policies

Regrade requests are to be used for alerting the teaching staff to correct answers which were marked incorrect or incidences of grading which are not in accordance with the posted rubric. Carefully reviewing all of the regrade requests takes time, so we need to have some policies in place to make sure that we are not inundated by random requests just trying to negotiate for more points for wrong answers. Please respect the TAs' time, and use the regrade option only in the case that your exam was graded erroneously. Students who abuse the regrade request button will be disallowed from making future regrade requests.

- (1) Before requesting any regrade, carefully compare your solutions to the exam solutions posted in the **Midterm Exam Solutions** module on Canvas.
- (2) If your answer differs from the answer in the posted solutions, please do not use the regrade request button to ask why your answer is incorrect; please bring that question to our office hours or post it on Piazza instead.
- (3) Please do not use the regrade request button to argue that a wrong answer deserves more partial credit. Regrade requests are only for incorrect grading which is not in accordance with the posted rubric.
- (4) Rubrics for each problem are published on Gradescope; please do not use the regrade request button to argue about changing the rubric, e.g. asking that something be worth two points instead of one.
- (5) The midterm regrade request option will be available from 8:00 AM on 11-7-22 until 11:59 PM on 11-10-22. After that time, we cannot consider any new regrade requests.
- (6) Any regrade request may result in a regrading of the entire exam, and your overall score could go up or down.

Note: The teaching staff will respond to all regrade requests by the end of the day on 11-13-22.
