

Visiting Scholar Criteria:

-Visiting Scholars normally possess a doctorate degree or foreign equivalent, but may be appointed with a baccalaureate/master's degree or be an undergraduate student visiting for the purposes of research or educational project.

Of Note: Must be a collaboration NOT a mentored project.

Conditions of Appointment:

-Visiting Scholar appointments are temporary and for a short period of time, not to exceed one year. Extension beyond one year may be permissible if the program warrants a longer affiliation.

-Visiting Scholars may **NOT** be a registered UC student, contractor or have another appointment/employment with the University.

- Visiting Scholars **MUST** have a home institution

- Brief description of the research with an explanation of how the research benefits UCSD.

- Office of Research Affairs who approves these appointments typically asks "What is this person doing for UCSD?"
